Conversation with the US EPA about Gowanus Canal flooding during Hurricane Sandy

After Hurricane Sandy, the EPA took water samples from the ground floor of two buildings that were flooded directly from the canal. Higher levels of bacteria were found but the toxic chemicals that are primary contaminants in Gowanus Canal sediment were below levels of concern or not detected.

This meeting will be an opportunity for Gowanus residents and business owners to speak with the EPA about the water sampling results and ask any questions they may have. Information will also be available on resources for those affected by the storm.
